

HOW TO FIND US





Simply let your gaze wander over Stuttgart, the station and the construction site. The rooftop terrace offers a clear view of the construction work on the through station.



Meetings in a unique location: Take your projects up a level by meeting in the modern conference room almost 30 metres above the excavation pit.

Explore the station and the region. What benefits will the rail project have for the S-Bahn? What does bwegt do? Discover how local and regional transport is organised in Baden-Württemberg. Find out what the future holds by steering your way through the new main station and its surrounding already. You can use a joystick to move around the immersive projection "The Cave" in real size and get a feel for the future station.



The future station is brought to life using augmented reality (AR). Experience how trains arrive and discover the new, short walking routes between the platform and the S-Bahn. What is the Stuttgart digital hub? And what will the new Stuttgart Rosenstein look like?
